The National Insurance Crime Bureau Insurance Fraud Analyst Academy provides the step-by-step techniques necessary to identify and analyze potential fraud "hidden" in your company's claims data. Students will analyze data to uncover patterns of possible fraud, create supporting documentation, and prepare reports needed to assist in developing investigational strategies, claims decisions and processes, and where applicable, referral to NICB and law enforcement.

Who should attend:	This is a basic course for insurance fraud analysts with 1-5 years of experience. Supervisors responsible for an insurance fraud analytical function may also benefit from attending
Limited registration:	Academy registration is limited to 20 students per session. If full, students will be placed on a waiting list for next scheduled academy
Academy Eligibility:	Academy attendance is restricted to the direct (not contracted) employees of member companies and the NICB Complete the Pre-Test (a score of 92% or higher is required to pass). After passing the pre-test, students will register and make payment online
Hardware Requirement:	Students must provide their own laptop with Microsoft Office 2007 and Power Cord (NOTE: 2003 is acceptable)
Dress Code:	Attire is Business Casual (no jeans, shorts, sweatshirts, t-shirts, athletic shoes, or hats while attending class)

NICB will provide morning beverages and lunch Monday- Thursday (no lunch on Friday)

PLEASE NOTE: If you are not currently registered as a student with NICTA, you will need to sign up and establish a new user account. Click on the New Student link located at the top left margin of the home page. Follow the instructions on the Sign Up pages and click Submit. **The first step is passing the Analyst Academy Pre-Test.** Click on Student Union located at the top menu bar. After the terms and conditions agreement page, click on Other Learning. Scroll down to select the *NICB Insurance Fraud Analyst Academy Pre-Test* (3rd link from the bottom).

After you take the Analyst Academy Pre-Test with a passing score of 92% or higher, click on Student Union, agree to the terms and conditions, click on Other Learning. Scroll down to select the *NICB Insurance Fraud Analyst Academy Registration* (2nd link from the bottom). When you click on the link, the class description page will appear, scroll down and click on enroll to fill out the registration form. Academy fees are paid via credit only (MasterCard or Visa).

Transportation: Airport to Hotel

Follow the signs to the **BUS SHUTTLE CENTER**. The signs will be hanging overhead at all domestic Terminals 1 through 3. When you get to the BUS SHUTTLE CENTER, please look for the courtesy phones on the far end of the hall. Please call the hotel using the courtesy phone to let us know that you arrived. Transportation: Hotel to NICB & NICB to Hotel

The Residence Inn by Marriott will provide transportation to NICB each day. Please meet in the hotel lobby at 8:00am each morning for shuttle service to NICB. The Training program starts promptly at 8:30am. At the end of each day, the Residence Inn shuttle will pick up students from NICB and take them back to the hotel.

Transportation in the evenings after students have been shuttled back to the hotel will be at the students own expense.
